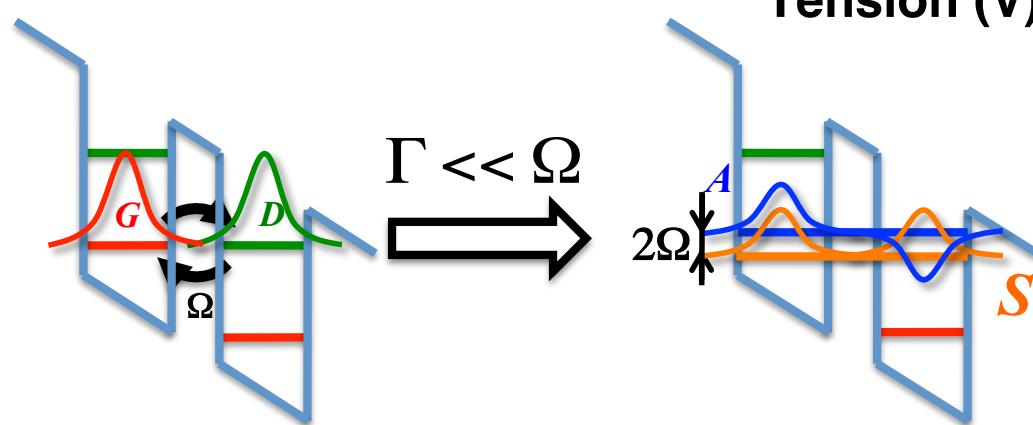
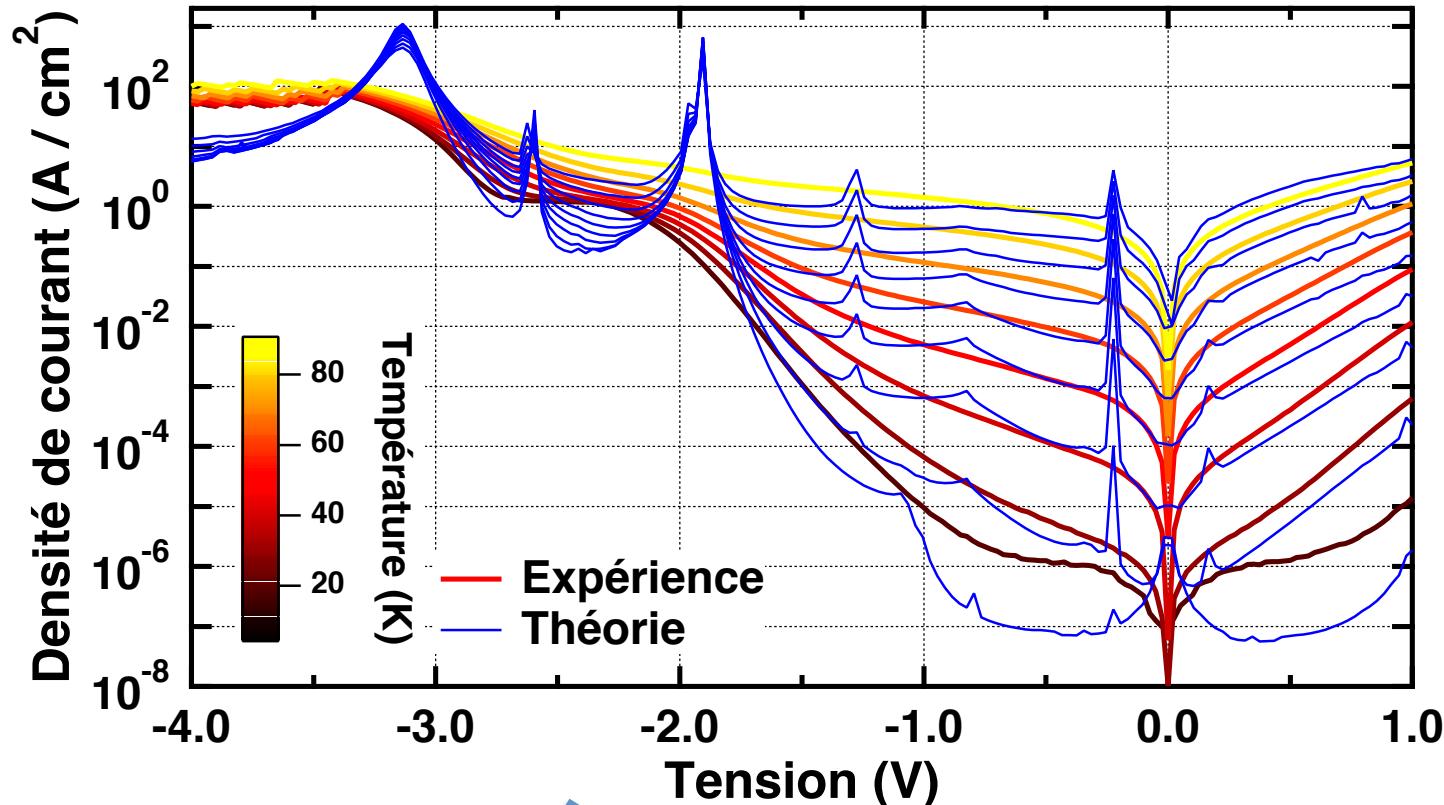


Inter-subband scattering

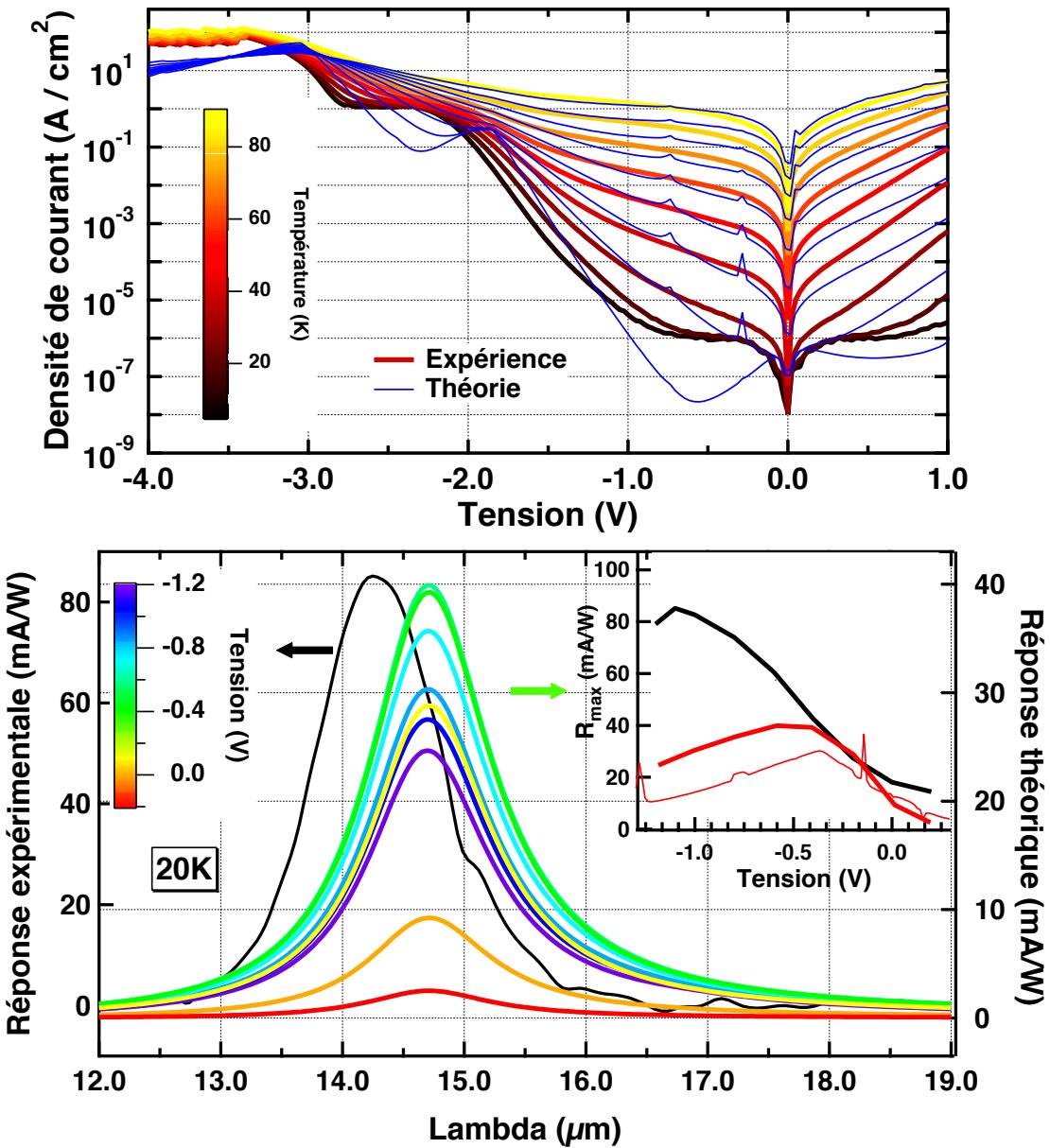


Hybrid model: principle

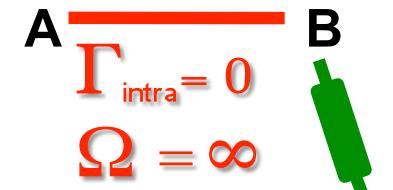
- **2nd order tunneling and absorption between pairs of localized states**
 - Generalization of Kazarinov and Suris formalism with energy conserved
 - Induces an effective “*tunnel diffusion time*”
 - Rabi coupling calculated as 1st order perturbation



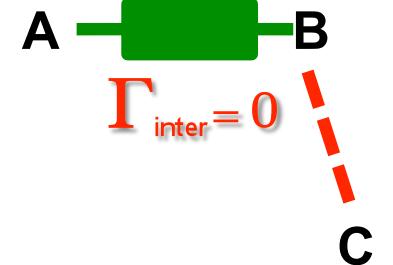

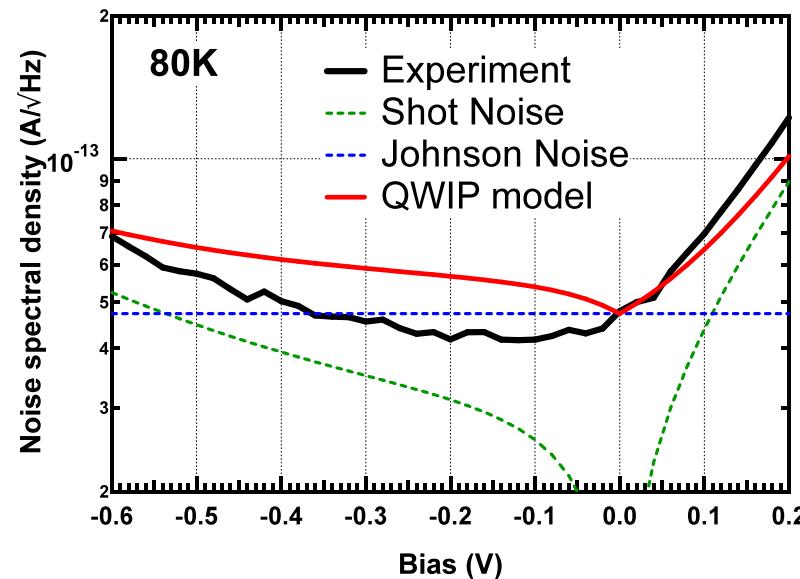
“Excess” shot noise Johnson noise
